CONFERENCE ANNOUNCEMENT AND CALL FOR PAPERS

BAFA Scotland is delighted to announce that the 2026 Annual Conference will be held at the University of the West of Scotland on **Wednesday 10 June 2026**.

Our conference is designed to provide:

- an opportunity for researchers (academics and doctoral students) to discuss and gain valuable feedback on their current work and research ideas;
- an opportunity to network with other academics; and
- an opportunity to join our network of support for Scottish-based academics.

The conference will feature keynote speeches/plenaries and parallel research presentation sessions throughout the day.

Paper Submission

We are now inviting original submissions of work addressing research questions in all areas of **Accounting and Finance**, including scholarship. Please note that there is no preference for any particular methodology or topic.

We actively encourage submissions from researchers at **all career stages**, including experienced faculty, early-career researchers, and doctoral/post-graduate research (PGR) students.

Submissions can be in one of two forms:

1. Full Papers – *completed or near completed research papers. These papers will be presented in parallel sessions with assigned discussants who will provide critical review comments. We believe that this feedback is an essential component of the conference experience, and we are committed to providing all authors with valuable insights that will help them advance their research.*
2. Emerging Papers – *research that is in its initial stages or the initial analysis of findings (e.g., early draft papers, emerging research ideas, and proposals). For this track, we*

*would expect authors to submit an extended abstract of **no less than 1,000 words**. This abstract should provide a good indication of the purpose of the research, the design/methodology/approach, the emerging themes, the preliminary findings (if any), the implications of the research, and its originality/value. Emerging papers will be presented under a shorter “Lightning Presentation” format, followed by a Q&A session with the audience.*

Please submit your work via email to scottish-ag@bafa.ac.uk by **Friday 15 May 2026** for it to be included in the conference programme. Please include: i) BAFAScotland2026, ii) your name, iii) your institutional affiliation, and iv) your role (i.e., academic or PGR) in the subject line of the email and your submitted file. For example, the file name should adopt the following construction: BAFAScotland2026-JoeBloggs-UoG-PGR.

Authors should also indicate in their email whether their paper should be considered for the FULL or EMERGING paper track.

Review and Selection

Selection will be undertaken by the BAFA Scotland Executive Committee after the submission deadline closes, with authors informed of the outcome in due course and no later than **22 May 2026**.

- Deadline for submission: 15 May 2026
- Notification of acceptance: 22 May 2026
- Conference date: 10 June 2026

Conference Registration Fees

- Academic staff: £50
- PhD students: £25

Fees cover conference registration, lunch, and refreshments throughout the day.

Registration will open in due course and will be via your BAFA Membership account. **Please note that numbers are strictly limited, so please sign-up fast when conference registration opens.**
